Extent of Primary Tumor:

- No evidence of primary tumor (pT0)
- Tumor 1 cm or smaller in greatest dimension without extrathyroidal extension (pT1a)
- Tumor larger than 1 cm but not larger than 2 cm in greatest dimension without extrathyroidal extension (pT1b)
- Tumor larger than 2 cm but not larger than 4 cm in greatest dimension without extrathyroidal extension (pT2)
- Tumor larger than 4 cm in greatest dimension without extrathyroidal extension (pT3a)
- Gross extrathyroidal extension invading only strap muscles (sternohyoid, sternothyroid, thyrohyoid, or omohyoid muscles) from a tumor of any size (pT3b)

- Gross extrathyroidal extension invading subcutaneous soft tissues, larynx, trachea, esophagus, or recurrent laryngeal nerve from a tumor of any size (pT4a)
- Gross extrathyroidal extension invading prevertebral fascia or encasing the carotid artery or mediastinal vessels from a tumor of any size (pT4b)

Lymph Node Status:
