

Primary Aldosteronism: Screening BPA Interpretation Guide

Abbreviations:

- PA, primary aldosteronism
- DRC, direct renin concentration
- PRA, plasma renin activity
- Aldo, aldosterone
- MR, mineralocorticoid receptor
- RAAS, renin-angiotensin-aldo system

Patient meets criteria
for PA screening

Hypertension AND:

- ≥4 antihypertensive agents
- Age <35 years
- Adrenal nodule
- Obstructive sleep apnea
- H/o of hypokalemia

Non-disruptive BPA

Renin not suppressed and the patient
is on RAAS-interfering medications

Plasma Renin
and Aldosterone

DRC >10 pg/mL AND Aldo/DRC ratio >2.6
PRA >1 ng/mL/h AND Aldo/PRA ratio >20

Suppressed renin

Michigan Medicine Assay

Some External Lab Assays

Direct renin concentration (DRC) <10 pg/mL
Plasma renin activity (PRA) <1 ng/mL/h

Aldo <10 ng/dL

Aldo 10-20 ng/dL

Aldo >20 ng/dL

Consider adding
a MR antagonist
